You can either use 36" tall upper cabinets, which allows for crown molding to be used along the top or you can use 42" tall upper cabinets that go all the way to the ceiling without any molding.

Upper cabinet heights include 12-inch, 15-inch, 18-inch, 24-inch, 30-inch, 36-inch, and 42-inch options, with shorter cabinets above fridges and stoves. Standard depths are 12, 15, 18, 24 ...

I noticed various cabinet manufactures only offer 30 and 42 inch wall cabinets and not 36". I have hung 36" cabinets with a 6" filler strip but never 42" with an eight foot ceiling.
