

Never dealt with metal studs before and my previous home had wood studs so regular screws were a no brainer. Do I just use 2 1/2 inch fine thread dry wall screws or will snap toggles work?

If you need to hang something heavy on metal studs, the process can be a bit more complicated than using traditional lumber studs. Here are the steps to follow to properly hang something ...
